Eligibility Criteria for Admission to Doctoral Degree Programme

A pass in Master's degree Programme in the concerned field of Specialization or an equivalent examination from Agricultural/Deemed Universities / Institutions recognised by ICAR with equivalent course duration, with a Cumulative Grade Point Average of 2.75 / 4.00 or Overall Grade Point Average of 7.50 / 10.00 or its equivalent. In case of candidates belonging to SC / ST / Cat-I, a mere pass would be adequate. For (i) **Ph.D. in Sericulture**: A candidate with M.Sc. (Agri.) in Agril. Entomology with specialisation in Sericulture is also eligible. (ii) **Ph.D. in Agril. Entomology**: A candidate with M.Sc. (Agri.) in Apiculture is also eligible.

Written Test

Candidates seeking Admission / Re-Admission (including candidates on deputation from State / Central Government and autonomous institutions) for Ph.D. degree programmes shall apply for **only one subject** and appear for a Written Test of 90 marks in the concerned subject.

II. MASTER'S DEGREE PROGRAMMES

The University offers Master's degree programmes in the following subjects at Bangalore, Shimoga and Ponnampet campuses.

BANGALORE - Subject groups

Group A (42 seats) : M.Sc. (Agri.) in Genetics and Plant Breeding / Seed Science & Technology / Crop Physiology / Plant Biochemistry / Plant Biotechnology.

Group B (30+4seats)** : M.Sc. (Agri.) in Agronomy / Soil Science and Agricultural Chemistry ** / Agricultural Microbiology.

- Group C (26 seats)** : M.Sc. (Hort.) in Fruit Science / Vegetable Science / Floriculture & Landscape Gardening/Plantation, Medicinal, Aromatic & Spice Crops / Post Harvest Technology * M.Sc. (Agri.) in Horticulture.
* **For candidates seeking re-admission only.**
- Group D (28 + 4**seats)** : M.Sc.(Agri.) in Agricultural Entomology ** / Plant Pathology / Apiculture / M.Sc. in Sericulture.
Eligibility: A pass in Bachelor's degree in Agriculture/Horticulture/ Forestry/ Sericulture for all the above Groups (A-D)
** **Offered at Shimoga Campus also.**
- Group E (36 seats)** : M.Sc. (Agri.) in Agricultural Economics / Agricultural Extension / Agricultural Statistics / Agricultural Marketing & Co-operation.
Eligibility: A pass in Bachelor's degree in Agriculture/Horticulture/ Forestry/ Sericulture/Agricultural Marketing and Co-operation (for Group E only).
- Group F (06 seats)** : M.Sc. (Agri.) in Food Science and Nutrition.
Eligibility: A pass in Bachelor's degree in Rural Home Science / Agriculture/Horticulture/Forestry/ Sericulture/Agricultural Marketing and Co-operation (for Group F only).
- Group G (06 seats)** : M.Tech. (Ag. Engg.) in Post Harvest Process and Food Engineering.
Eligibility: A pass in B. Tech. (Ag.Engg.) / B.Sc. (Ag.Engg.) / BE (Agri.) (for Group G only).
- Group H (12 seats)** : M.Sc. (Agri.) in Environmental Science / M.Sc. (Forestry)*
Eligibility: A pass in Bachelor's degree in Forestry / Agriculture / Horticulture / Sericulture. (for Group H only).
* Offered at Ponnampet campus only.
- Group I (24 seats)** : MBA (Agri-Business Management)
Eligibility: A pass in four years Bachelor's Degree from a recognised Agricultural University / Horticulture / Veterinary & Animal Sciences / Deemed University / Institution recognised by ICAR with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 / 4.00 or OGPA of 7.00 / 10.00 or its equivalent. In case of Candidates belonging to SC/ST and Category-I, a mere pass would be adequate.

Candidates seeking admission to Master's degree programmes in the University should possess Bachelor's degree from a recognised Agricultural / Deemed Universities/ Institutions recognised by ICAR in terms of course duration of **four** years, with a minimum CGPA of 2.50/4.00 or OGPA of 7.00/10.00 or its equivalent. In case of candidates belonging to SC/ST/ Category-I, mere pass would be adequate. Candidates who have studied under Trimester system should compulsorily submit a copy of the Certificate declaring equivalent percentage of marks issued by the competent authority, failing which their applications will be rejected.

Written Test

Candidates including those on deputation from recognised State / Central Governments and autonomous institutions seeking admission to Master's degree programmes shall apply for only one Subject Group of his / her choice and appear for Written Test of 180 marks covering all the subjects included under that Group. Candidates seeking re-admission, have to appear for the Written Test in the concerned subject only of the concerned Group.

Candidates seeking admission to Ph.D. degree programme are required to submit a copy of the marks card of the qualifying examination (Master's degree) to the University on or before **12th August, 2009**.

MBA (ABM): All eligible candidates will have to appear for a Written Test for 100 marks which includes Knowledge on Agricultural Technology (KAT), Management Aptitude Test (MAT), Mathematics, Statistics and English. This will be followed by a group discussion and an interview.

❑ Domicile requirement (only for admission to Master's degree)

In addition to the above prescribed qualifications, candidate for Master's degree should be a citizen of India and must have studied in any educational institution in Karnataka state for a **minimum period of seven academic years** at any time upto Bachelor's degree as on 1st July, 2009. (Domicile requirement is not applicable for Ph.D. degree programme and for candidates on deputation).

Exceptions

The provision prescribed above shall not apply in case of candidates who fulfill any one of the following, provided appropriate certificates of proof are furnished in support of their claim. In what follows, 'children' means only 'natural born' children and not 'adopted' children.

- i. Children of Defence personnel, Central Government employees and employees of statutory Corporation set up, owned or controlled by the Central Government or Karnataka State Government serving in the state both on the date of making the application and during the period of atleast 12 months immediately before such date.
- ii. Children of State Government employees including children of members of the All India Services borne on the Karnataka State Cadre who:
 - a) are serving or have served outside the State of Karnataka on deputation during the relevant period.
 - b) are in the service of the State of Karnataka on the date of making the application or have retired from the service prior to the date of making the application.
- iii. Children of working or retired employees of Central or State Government or joint-sector undertaking where employees:
 - a) had declared to the Central Government any place in Karnataka state as *the home town.
 - b) had either studied in any educational institution in the state of Karnataka, run or recognised by the Government of Karnataka, for not less than seven years at any time prior to the last date fixed for receipt of application or has passed Bachelor's degree in Karnataka.
- iv. Children of serving defence personnel or Ex-Servicemen whose home address at the time of joining the defence service was in Karnataka. Proof of such domicile should be produced either by obtaining the extract from the Record Office of the Defence Units or a Certificate from Rajya Zilla Sainik Board.

Note: Candidates claiming seat under exception clause as above should produce relevant documents in support of their claim.

III. DURATION OF DEGREE PROGRAMMES

A minimum of two academic years (4 Semesters) shall ordinarily be required for the completion of course work, research, thesis / Project preparation and examinations leading to the award of Master's degree. A minimum period of three academic years (6 Semesters) shall be required for completion of the Ph.D. degree programme.

IV . MODE OF ADMISSION

1. Admission for the seats which are not reserved shall be in accordance with merit as determined by the P.G. Admission Committee, the relative merit being determined as follows :

- To be eligible for admission / re-admission a candidate should secure a minimum of 50 per cent of marks from out of the above criteria for being considered for admission to the degree programme. In case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe / Category - I, a minimum of 35 per cent of marks is adequate.
 - If a candidate has more than one of the above, the maximum marks in any one of the above shall be considered.
 - The sports & games / cultural events recognized by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) New Delhi shall only be considered.
 - The weightage shall be considered only for 'representation' during the qualifying degree programme for admission.

5. The weightage shall be considered only for 'representation' during the qualifying degree programme Schlorship or fellowship.
6. Candidates who were admitted previously to Postgraduate degree programmes and have completed 75 per cent of the course work are eligible for re-admission.
7. Candidates, who have studied under Trimester system seeking Ph.D./Master's degree admission / re-admission, should compulsorily submit a copy of the certificate declaring equivalent percentage marks issued by the competent authority.

c) Mode of Admission for MBA (ABM)

Admission to the programme is based on merit as determined by the P. G. Admission Committee. The relative merit being determined as follows:

1. The ratio of candidates to be called for Group Discussion shall be **1 : 3** from among the candidates appearing for the Written Test.
 2. The ratio of candidates to be called for Interview shall be **1 : 2** among the candidates appearing for the Group Discussion.
 3. The merit list will be prepared based on the weightage of marks scored as per the above criteria.
 4. A candidate should secure a minimum of 50 per cent marks to become eligible for admission. In case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe / Category-I, a minimum of 35 per cent marks is adequate.
 5. The above weightage of marks shall be considered only for admission.

V. RESERVATION OF SEATS

- a) Reservation of seats in favour of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes will be in accordance with the reservation policy stipulated by the Government of Karnataka from time to time. G.O. No. SWD 225 BCA 2000 dt. 30th March, 2002 (new comprehensive creamy layer policy).
- b) If seats belonging to any of the Categories referred to above are not filled due to non-availability of eligible candidates, the reservation to that extent shall stand reduced and shall be transferred to the General Merit category as per the G.O. No. ED/47/TEC/97 dated 3.5.97.
- c) **Candidates on deputation from State / Central / Autonomous Institutions:** A provision has been made to admit eight candidates for Master's and four candidates for Doctoral degree programmes over and above the normal intake prescribed, restricting only one seat for each group / subject with allocation purely on merit basis i.e., on the total marks obtained as per the admission procedure. The deputed candidates shall compulsorily forward their application through their employer within the last date prescribed for submission of filled in application, failing which their application shall not be considered. Further, such candidates shall also submit their deputation order compulsorily on or before 12th August 2008.
- d) Three per cent of the seats are reserved for physically challenged candidates at the level of M.Sc. degree programme (subject-groups) and overall *inter se* of subject. In case of Doctoral degree programme a maximum of one seat in each subject will be considered over and above the seat matrix.
- e) Five seats (2 for Sports and Games; 2 for Cultural activities and One for NSS) shall be reserved for students who have excelled in Sports / Games / Cultural and NSS activities during their Undergraduate programme in the University. This shall be applicable only for Master's degree programme including MBA (ABM). The seats reserved shall be over and above the prescribed intake matrix as per the reservation order of the Government of Karnataka.
- f)
 - 1) SC/ST candidates to produce certificate in Form-D (See Rule 3A (2) (3)). Government Order No. SWDSD : 97 (1) Bangalore, Dated 8-2-2000.
 - 2) Category-1 candidates to produce certificate in Form-E (See Rule 3A (2) (3)). Government Order No. SWD : 132 SD : 97 (1) Dated 8-2-2000.
 - 3) Candidates belonging to backward class (IIA, IIB, IIIA & IIIB) to produce income and caste certificate in Form-F (See Rule 3A (2) (3)). Government Order No. SaKaE 225/BCA/2002/ 30-3-2002.

VI. COUNSELLING AND MODE OF ALLOCATION OF SEATS

a) Master's Degree

A common *inter se* merit list for each group of subjects will be prepared and the admission committee will allot the seats subject-wise in each group on the date of counselling, based on the merit and reservation policy of State Government following the rotation system as per the details indicated in the matrix for furnished in the Annexure -II of this Prospectus.

b) Doctoral Degree

There will be no counselling for Doctoral degree programme. A subject-wise / overall *inter se* merit list will be prepared and the Admission Committee will allot the seats, following overall *inter se* / subject-

wise *inter se* with a stipulation to limit one seat per subject. The seats unfilled under categories due to non-availability of eligible candidates will be transferred to General Merit category in the subjects where the vacancies are available based on the merit and reservation policy of the State Government. The selected candidates will be intimated and they should register for the course within the stipulated date by producing all the original transcripts and by paying the prescribed fee.

c) MBA (ABM)

A common merit list will be prepared and the admission committee will allot the seats on the counselling date, based on the merit and reservation policy of the State Government.

VII. ADMISSION

The candidates selected shall pay the prescribed fee immediately, **only** in the form of Demand Draft drawn in favour of Comptroller, UAS, Bangalore.

VIII. REGISTRATION

The candidates admitted to PG programme and MBA (ABM) after paying the prescribed fee shall report to the concerned HOD for advice on the courses to be taken and complete the prescribed formalities of Registration on or before the date of commencement of the I Semester of 2009-10 so as to place them on the rolls of the University.

- Note:
- 1) Candidates are required to submit two copies of recent passport size photographs for group health insurance at the time of Counselling-cum-Admission.
 - 2) Students belonging to SC/ST/ Category-I who are eligible for concession are required to pay fees which are not reimbursible by the Government as per G.O. No. SWL 229 BCA 80 dated 16-12-1982 and as amended from time to time. The details of the concession to various categories are mentioned in the 'Instructions to Candidates'. Candidates must produce two photocopies of caste certificate to claim concession of fees.
 - 3) All fees indicated in the prospectus are subject to change with the approval of the University.
 - 4) Candidates may retain Photocopies of their category / income certificate since the originals will be retained by the University at the time of admission.
 - 5) NRIs / Foreign Nationals are required to pay the prescribed fees and US Dollars (\$) 4000 per annum as Institutional Economic Fees. However, the Institutional Economic Fees for candidates from SAARC countries is US Dollars (\$) 2000 per annum, besides prescribed fees.
 - 6) Afghan nationals are required to pay an additional US Dollars (\$) 1,000 towards English language proficiency course, besides the prescribed Fees and Institutional Economic Fees. Grpup Health Insurance Rs. 1,000/-
 - 7) Fees received from a PG student choosing a subject shall be reappropriated incase the student is given admission to any other subject of his/her choice in the University during the **same** academic year.
 - 8) Caution money is refundable only after successful completion of the Postgraduate degree programme for which a candidate is admitted or on discontinuing the Postgraduate degree programme on his / her request. The student shall claim the caution money after furnishing a No Dues Certificate from all the concerned, after due notification by the Registrar.
 - 9) Fees once paid by the student is non-refundable except Caution money deposit.

X. SCHOLARSHIPS

1. University Resident Merit Scholarship (URMS) shall be awarded to candidates in each of the subjects under the Master's (Rs. 800/- per month) as well as Doctoral Degree Programmes (Rs. 1,200/- per month) during each academic year, and will be restricted to those students who have graduated from the University of Agricultural Sciences, Bangalore / Dharwad. Candidates from the State departments and candidates who have been sponsored or drawing salary are not eligible for URMS. One scholarship shall be awarded for every ten students or part thereof.
2. All SC / ST students are required to **compulsorily** apply for Government of India scholarship and the other category students are required to apply for fee concession to Government of Karnataka.

XI. HOSTEL FACILITIES

Hostel facilities shall be provided at specified campuses to the extent available on first-cum-first serve basis. Duly filled-in prescribed application form for admission to the hostel, should be submitted to the concerned Hostel Warden well in advance of the commencement of the academic year.

- 1) At the time of admission each boarder shall have to pay one time mess deposit as indicated below which shall be refunded at the time of the boarder leaving the Hostel subject to clearance of all the dues.

Note : Hostels are governed by hostel regulations, copies of which shall be provided to each boarder at the time of admission to the hostel.

XII. GENERAL

- 1) The students admitted to the University shall abide by the Rules and Regulations of the University prescribed from time to time.
- 2) Separate rules in respect of students discipline in class rooms, hostels and campuses are given in the University Calendar.
- 3) The student failing to appear for Written Test / Counselling and payment of prescribed fees on stipulated date and time will automatically forfeit the claim for admission.
- 4) The right to change / modify any or all condition (s) prescribed in this prospectus is / are at the sole discretion of the University.
