

For the nomination of students, please consider the following guideline:

For the nominations, you need to **start a pre-selection procedure of students** in your institution. For us, the pre-selection must be based on the following application criteria/documents

- 1. Cover/motivation letter (addressing the ERASMUS+ coordinator Dr. Martin Wiehle)
- 2. up-to-date CV
- 3. up-to-date transcript of record (ECTS) & certificates; above average achievements
- 4. **language certificates** (ideally TOEFL, IELTS, or appropriate proofs of an environment where the medium of instruction for the nominee was/is the respective language):
 - English (for international M.Sc. AGES, IFBC or SIA programs): B2 or higher or
 - German (for German B.Sc./M.Sc. Organic Agriculture programs): B2 or higher
