Celebration of 75th Republic Day

UAS, BANGALORE celebrated the 75th Republic Day, the National festival at GKVK, Bengaluru on 26th January, 2024 to commemorate the foundation of a Republic India. Dr. S.V. Suresha, Vice-Chancellor of UAS-B garlanded the Mahatma Gandhi Statue, Kuvempu Statue, Dr. Puttarudraiah bust, Ragi Lakshmanaiah bust and Dr. K.C. Naik bust before hoisting the tri-colour National Flag chaperoned by Dr. N.B. Prakash, Dean of Student Welfare. The guard mounting was presented by NCC Cadets at flag hoist. Vice-Chancellor expressed that the 75th year of the Republic is truly a historic milestone in the journey of the Nation. India being



the 5th largest growing economy of the world, is in forefront due to incredible growth and development of various sectors including Agriculture, he articulated. He stated that in spite of enhanced food production, the sector also faces several challenges, which includes climate change, socio-economic issues of the farmers and global economic crisis. He added that the climate change will not only affect the food and nutritional security, besides it leads to water scarcity, drought, heat waves, flooding, infestation by invasive pests and so on and hence, the University wishes to take up research programmes on impact of climate change on individual crops. He said new initiatives in farming sector, bringing sea change through application of digital technologies, soil mapping & crop survey software, agri start-ups, cloud based solutions, IoT in Agriculture, use of drone technology, artificial intelligence, machine learning, etc., would be given prime importance to provide innovative solutions to the farming sector. Vice-Chancellor congratulated the students for their legacy in academics, sports & culture over the years. He concluded by saying, let us remember the Nation's golden heritage and salute - Happy Republic Day to all. The day was celebrated at all the constituent Colleges and Units of the University.

RSKs of Chikkaballapura and Bengaluru Rural Districts to gain practical experience. As part of RAWEP, students organized 196 group discussion & general meetings on various topics; 17 animal health camps; 17 mass tree planting, 31 *Swaccha*

Bharath programmes; 191 demonstrations on method of composting, azolla cultivation, seed treatment, soil sampling, ragi malt preparation, bore well recharge, bio gas production, rain water harvesting, zero energy cooling centre, etc. Over 480 field visits were made to problematic fields by scientists along with the students. Seventeen Krishimela-cum-exhibition and interaction sessions were also organized. Shri Sharath Bacche Gowda, Hon'ble MLA, Hoskote constituency and Hon'ble Members, BoM of UAS-B inaugurated the crop museum at Ittasandra of Hoskote taluk, while Dr. S.V.
