

About the Conference

As the global population is expected to reach 9 billion by 2050, food insecurity remains a critical challenge. Efforts to increase food production are complicated by widespread land degradation and the growing impacts of climate change. In India, over 120 million hectares—more than one-third of the country's total land area—are classified as degraded. The unpredictability of weather patterns in recent years has only intensified the difficulties of addressing land degradation and boosting crop productivity.

To tackle these issues, the Government of India has launched integrated watershed development initiatives aimed at combating land degradation in rainfed areas while simultaneously enhancing productivity. Karnataka has been a leader in these efforts, implementing groundbreaking projects. Recent initiatives, such as Sujala-3 and the REWARD project, use science-based Land Resource Inventory (LRI) methods, which provide detailed, parcel-level data on soil nutrients, crop suitability, and water conservation structures.

The primary goal of this conference is to share insights gained from the implementation of the LRI approach in watershed development projects in Karnataka and Odisha. The conference will also explore the potential for scaling these practices across other regions of India. It will offer targeted recommendations for refining methodologies and approaches, and influencing policies to promote the wider adoption of innovative and sustainable watershed management practices.

The conference will be structured around expert-led presentations on key topics, followed by interactive discussions. Around 250 delegates to attend, including officials from the Department of Land Resources (DoLR), National Rainfed Area Authority (NRAA), Watershed Development Department (WDD) of the Government of Karnataka (GoK), representatives from State Agricultural Universities (SAUs), the National Bureau of Soil Survey and Land Use Planning (NBSS&LUP), State-Level Nodal Agencies (SLNAs) from various states, NGOs, progressive farmers from Karnataka, and invited experts.
