# 59<sup>th</sup> Convocation of University of Agricultural Sciences, Bangalore

**UAS, BANGALORE** celebrated its 59<sup>th</sup> Convocation on 15<sup>th</sup> May, 2025, in a formal ceremony steeped in tradition and symbolism, to award various degrees to its graduating students. Dr. S.V. Suresha, Vice-Chancellor extended a warm welcome to the dignitaries and attendees, highlighting the University's notable achievements. Shri Thawarchand Gehlot, Hon'ble Governor of Karnataka and Chancellor of the University conferred degrees and gold medals in the esteemed company of Shri N. Chaluvarayaswamy, Hon'ble



Minister of Agriculture, GoK. A total of 1,271 students were awarded degrees, comprising 871 Bachelor's Degrees, 311 Master's Degrees, and 89 Doctoral Degrees. As many as 150 gold medals and certificates were presented to 63 students. On this momentous occasion Shri V. Balasubramanian, IAS (Rtd.) along with Shri Yogendra Kumar, Marketing Director of IFFCO and Chairman of Bhartiya Beej Sahakari Samiti Ltd., were honoured with 'Honorary Doctorate'. Hon'ble Governor emphasized the critical role of scientists, policymakers, and innovators in addressing global challenges such as climate change, water scarcity, soil degradation and pesticide contamination. The Hon'ble Minister of Agriculture remarked on the government's commitment to integrated farming and AIdriven digital agriculture. In his Convocation address, Dr. U.S. Awasthi, Managing Director, IFFCO, New Delhi articulated that agriculture transcends mere food production; it is the backbone of the Indian economy, the lifeblood of rural communities and vital for maintaining ecological balance. Hon'ble Members of BoM and all the Officers of the University took part in the ceremony.
