Annexure-1**I. Qualifications prescribed for Direct Recruitment of Subject Matter Specialist (T-6) KVKs in UAS, Bengaluru.****SUBJECT MATTER SPECIALIST (T-6)****Qualification:**

1. Master's degree in the relevant field or .equivalent qualifications from a recognized University.
2. B.Sc. Degree in any recognised Agriculture University.
3. Selection procedure for the post of Subject Matter Specialist.

a)	The maximum age limit prescribed for the posts shall be in accordance with the Karnataka Civil Services (General_ Recruitment) Rules, 1977, as amended from time to time.
b)	Composition of Selection Committee for direct recruitment to the post of Subject Matter Specialist at KVKs, in UAS, Bengaluru: The Selection Committee shall have the following composition.
1	Director of Education, UAS, Bengaluru shall be the Chairperson of the Selection Committee
2	Director, ICAR-Agricultural Technology Application Research Institute (ATARI), Bengaluru or his nominee.
3	Head of the concerned department either college or University level not below the rank of Professor.
4	Two outside subject experts nominated by the Vice Chancellor.
5	Director of Extension, UAS, Bengaluru.
6	One outside subject expert representing SC/ST/OBC/Minority/Women/Differently-abled categories to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor if any of the candidates representing the categories is the applicant and if any of the above members of the selection committee do not belong to that category.
At least four members including the chairperson, Director, ICAR-ATARI and one outside subject expert shall constitute the quorum.

	b) PUC/10+2	Maximum marks allotted= 04 4 marks shall be awarded on Pro-rata on the basis of the percentage of marks scored in PUC/10+ 2 considering 50% = 0 and 100% = 4 marks. Note: The candidates shall compulsorily furnish an attested copy of the PUC/10+2 marks card.
