EXPLANATORY NOTES FOR ALLOTMENT OF MARKS

1	Qualifications	60 Marks
1.1	Academic Qualifications	Maximum marks allotted = 55 a) SSLC (5 Marks) – 5 marks on <i>Prorata</i> basis (35%=0) b) PUC (10 Marks) – 10 marks on <i>Prorata</i> basis (35%=0) c) Degree (40 marks) For Bachelor degree – 40 marks at <i>Prorata</i> basis. Under 4 point grade, 2.00 gets 0 and 4.00 gets 40 marks. Under Semester system, 6.00 gets 0 and 10.00 gets 40 marks. d) In case of degree from traditional University, - 35 Marks gets 0 and 100 Marks gets 40 Marks. <i>(For BSc with PG Diploma, the Marks of both the programmes will be taken on 50 : 50 basis when qualification is essential).</i>
1.2	Additional Qualifications	Maximum marks allotted = 5 a) Ph.D – 3 Marks b) MSc/Post-graduation/Post graduate Diploma of not less than one year duration in the concerned subject – 2.0 marks each. c) Any other training programmes in the concerned subject involving: i) More than 3 months duration – 1 mark per training programme ii) 1 month to 3 months duration – ½ mark per training programme. iii) For less than 1 month training programme – ¼ mark per training programme.

Experience	10 Marks Two Marks shall be given per year of experience in Teaching, Research and Extension in the cadre of Instructor including Temporary appointments as Programme Assistant/Research Associate /Full time Sr.Research Fellow/Jr.Research Fellow/Merit Associate/ Technical Assistant/Assistant Professor
3	Publications	15 Marks
3.1	Published Papers: For research papers published in standard scientific journals, for full paper – 1 mark each.	
3.2.	For research note/short communication published in standard journals or periodicals like current research, etc.:- 0.5 mark each.	
3.3	Papers presented and documented in Seminar/Symposia/Conferences at international level – 0.5 mark each (Maximum 5 marks).	
3.4	Popular article published in leading Dailies/Institutional/Government Departments/ Periodicals – 0.25 mark each (Maximum 5 marks).	

3.5	Papers presented and documented in National conferences/Symposia/Seminar and also article published in souvenir – 0.25 mark each (Maximum 5 marks)	
3.6	Research bulletins / Extension bulletins / Extension folders / Chapters in books published by Universities / National institutes / Standard commercial publishers – 0.25 mark each (Maximum 5 marks)

4.1	a) International – 4.0 marks for each b) National/Jawaharlal Nehru/Rajyothsava – 3.0 marks c) UAS Gold Medal – 1.5 marks d) Private Gold Medal instituted through University (if more than one Gold Medal is awarded, highest award shall be considered) – only one award for entire degree – 1.0 mark e) State Award – 1.0 mark for each f) Professional Society – 1.0 mark for each g) Others – 0.5 mark for each (Maximum 2.00 marks) <i>If a candidate earns more than one award for the same degree/achievement, the highest award will be considered for allotting the marks.</i> <i>Note:</i> <i>1. International means the awards by the organizations which are of International repute and established by the International funding to further the research need of the International Community (Eg.ICRISAT, etc.)</i> <i>2. National level awards means the awards issued at the national level.</i> <i>3. Professional Society means any registered scientific society.</i> <i>4. Others, means any other awards which is not covered above.</i>

General:

- The eligibility as well as suitability of a candidate shall be considered based on the information supplied by him/her in the application.
- All the items as mentioned in the application and supported by the relevant and valid documents only will be taken into consideration for award of marks.
- Prescribed qualifications must have been obtained from Registrar/Competent authority on or before the last date for submission of application.
- Any additional document after submission of application will not be entertained.
- If a candidate has given more than one application for the same post, the latest application will be considered as valid for the purpose of recruitment.
- Medals will be considered as University awards.
- Any number of medals/awards received for the same achievement will be considered as only one award attracting higher marks. For example, if a candidate secures more than one gold medal for standing first in the class, he/she will be entitled for 3 marks only as University award.

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
